Purpose: Help you choose balloon colours that perfectly match your event theme.

Step 1: Define Your Event Purpose

- What is the celebration? (Birthday, baby shower, wedding, corporate event)
- Who is the guest of honour?
- Is the event formal, casual, or playful?

Step 2: Identify the Event Theme - Theme name: Mood/feeling: Inspiration source:	
Step 3: Assess the Venue - Venue name & location: - Indoor or outdoor? - Existing colours: - Lighting type: natural / warm / cool	
Step 4: Choose Your Main Colour - Main balloon colour: (This will be your anchor colour)	
Step 5: Add Supporting Colours - Supporting colour 1: Supporting colour 2:	
Step 6: Select an Accent Colour - Accent balloon colour: (Use sparingly for highlights)	-
Step 7: Decide on Balloon Finishes	

- Matte
- Glossy latex
- Chrome / metallic
- Transparent with confetti
- Pastel tone

Step 8: Check Colour Balance

- More than four colours? Yes / No
- Complementary colours? Yes / No
- Stand out in venue? Yes / No

Step 9: Test Under Lighting

- Test balloon sample under venue lighting before buying in bulk.

Step 10: Coordinate With Other Décor

- Match with tablecloths, flowers, signage, and other decorations.

Quick Colour Inspiration:

Tropical party: Teal, Coral, Yellow, Gold

Romantic wedding: Blush pink, Ivory, Champagne gold, Rose gold

Safari adventure: Tan, Olive, Deep green, Bronze Winter wonderland: Icy blue, White, Silver, Navy

Tips:

- Stick to 3-4 colours for a clean look.
- Use metallics for elegance and pastels for softness.
- Always secure balloons properly, especially outdoors.
